### BABY ALPACA GRANDE Cabled Cowl



Approx. Finished Size: 20" (24)" Approx. Finished Length: 15" (12")

#### **Materials:**

Baby Alpaca Grande: 2 – 100g skeins, shown in color 401

Light Grey

**Gauge:** 12 sts = 4" using size 10.5 needles over

stockinette st.

Needles: Size US 10.5; 16" circular; Cable Needle.

#### Tall thin Cowl- 20" around:

**K2-P2 ribbing:** \*(K2, p2); repeat from \* around. C6B: Place next 3 sts on a cable needle, hold in back, knit next 3 sts, knit the 3 sts from the cable needle.

With larger needles starting at the bottom edge, loosely cast on 80 sts.

Join into the round. Place marker at beginning of round. Work in k2-p2 ribbing for 4 rounds.

Begin cable pattern.

Round 1-4: \*(K2, p1, k6, p1); repeat from \* around. Round 5: \*(K2, p1, C6B, p1); repeat from \* around. Round 6-8: Repeat round 1.

Repeat rounds 1-8 until total length is about 14" or until almost out of yarn, leaving enough left for 4 rounds of ribbing and the bind off, and ending on a round 8 if possible.

Work 4 rounds of k2- p2 ribbing, decreasing 4 sts evenly around the first round to 76 sts. Bind off loosely in ribbing. Weave in all ends.

#### Shorter wider Cowl- 24" around

With larger needles starting at the bottom edge, loosely cast on 100 sts.

Join into the round. Place marker at beginning of round. Work in k2-p2 ribbing for 4 rounds. Begin cable pattern.

Round 1-4: \*(K2, p1, k6, p1); repeat from \* around.

Round 5: \*(K2, p1, C6B, p1); repeat from \* around.

Round 6-8: Repeat round 1.

Repeat rounds 1-8 until total length is about 11" or until almost out of yarn, leaving enough left for 4 rounds of ribbing and the bind off, and ending on a round 8 if possible.

Work 4 rounds of k2- p2 ribbing. Bind off loosely in ribbing. Weave in all ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS: dec = decrease, inc = increase, k = knit, k2tog = knit two together, psso = pass slip stitch over, p = purl, RS= right side, sl = slip, SSK = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tbl = through back loop, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side, yo = yarn over, wyif = with yarn in front, wyib = with yarn in back.
