SOFT SERVE Sailboat Baby Blanket

Actual Finished Dimensions: Approx. 29" x 33"

Materials:

Soft Serve: 4 - 100g balls, shown in color 602 Blueberry

Gauge: Approx. 18 st = 4" on size 7

needle.

Needles: Size US 6 circular needle, 24"or longer; size US 7 circular

needle, 24" or longer.

Sailboat Blanket:

With smaller circular needle cast on 127 sts. Knit 10 rows.

Change to larger circular needle.

Row 1: k6, pm, knit to last 6 sts, pm, k6.

Row 2: k6, slip marker, purl across to marker, slip marker, k6. Repeat rows 1 and 2 of stockinette st 3 times.

Note: keep first six and last six sts in garter st for entire afghan to form border.

Boat Pattern:

NOTE: There are 7 boats acrosseach separated by 3 stockinette sts. We suggest you place markers at each side of each boat.



Each boat is 13 sts wide. The charts show 2 boats just for your ease of use.

So there are: 6 garter sts, 3 st sts, 13 boat sts, 3 st st, 6 garter sts.

Begin on RS: k6 (border sts), work 3 stockinette sts, work the 1st row of the graph, repeating for a total of 7 boats, work 3 more stockinette sts, end k6 (border sts). At the widest point, each boat is 13 sts wide, and separated by 3 st sts from the adjacent boats,

and by 3 st sts from each border.


Continue in this manner for rows 2 through 25 of the graph to form one set of 7 sailboats. Next, work in st st with garter st borders until blanket measures 26.5" from cast-on. Then work another set of 7 sailboats, turning the graph upside down, ie, so the bottoms of the 7 boats will be closest to the edge of the blanket.

Finishing:

Work 8 more rows of st st with garter st borders. Finish with smaller needle and 10 rows of garter st.

Bind off. Weave in all ends.

Sailboat Graph

(Right Side Facing)

= use purl stitch on RS

If box is empty, knit on RS, purl on WS.

Separate the boats from the border, and from each other(as shown), by 3 stockinette sts.
