# ENCORE WORSTED <br> Hat and Mitten Set 



To Fit Child's Size 6-8, (10-12, ladies small/medium)
Hat Circumference: 18", $(19,20)$
Mitten Palm Circumference: 5 ½", ( $6^{1 ⁄ 2}$, 7 ¼)

## Materials:

Encore Worsted (For Set):
$1-100 \mathrm{~g}$ balls, color MC 469 Storm Blue
$1-100 \mathrm{~g}$ balls, color CC 466 Quarry
Gauge: 5 sts $=1 "$ in st st on size 8 knitting needles.

## Needles:

For Hat: Size US 8-16" circular, size 8 double pointed needles, stitch marker, size J crochet hook. For Mittens: Size US 8 double points, stitch markers, scrap yarn.

Pattern is written for smallest size, with larger sizes in parenthesis. If only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

## Hat

## Earflaps

With size 8 double point and MC, Cast on 3 sts.
Work 2 rows MC and 2 rows CC throughout.
Row 1: k1, m1, knit to last st, m1.
Row 2: purl across all sts.
Repeat these 2 rows until there are $19,(21,21)$ sts on the needle. Set aside and make an identical earflap.

## Join earflaps to hat

For the body of the hat, you be working a stripe pattern of 4 rounds MC and 4 rounds CC , alternating the stripes. With MC and size $8-16$ " circular, Cast on $11,(11,12)$ sts (half of back of hat), knit across $19,(21,21)$ sts from first earflap, Cast on $31,(32,35)$ sts (FRONT of hat), knit across 19, $(21,21)$ sts from second earflap, Cast on 10, (10, 11) sts (half of back of hat). $90,(95,100)$ sts on needle.

Join in the round, being careful not to twist. Work in st st in the round for $5 \frac{1}{4}$ ", ( $5 \frac{3}{4}, 6 \frac{1}{4}$ ) from hat cast on.
Decrease for Top
Round 1: *k3, k2tog; rep from * around.
Round 2 and every other round: knit all sts.
Round 3: knit across all sts
Round 5: *k2, k2tog; rep from * around
Round 7: knit across all sts.
Round 9: *k1, k2tog; rep from * around.
Round 11: *k2tog; rep from * around.
Cut yarn and draw through remaining sts. Pull tight and fasten off.
With crochet hook and 2 strands of MC, work 1 row of sc along the earflap edges and the hat cast on edge.
ABBREVIATIONS: $\mathrm{CC}=$ contrast color, dec = decrease, inc = increase, $\mathrm{kf} \& \mathrm{~b}=$ knit into the front and back of stitch, $\mathrm{k}=\mathrm{knit}, \mathrm{MC}=$ main color, $\mathrm{m} 1=$ make one, $\mathrm{m}=$ marker, $\mathrm{pm}=$ place marker, $\mathrm{psso}=$ pass slip stitch over, $\mathrm{pm}=$ place marker, $\mathrm{p}=\mathrm{purl}, \mathrm{RS}=$ right side, $\mathrm{sl}=$ slip, $\mathrm{SSK}=$ slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) $=$ stitch $(\mathrm{es})$, st $\mathrm{st}=$ stockinette st, tbl = through back loop, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side, yo = yarn over, wyif = with yarn in front, wyib = with yarn in back.

## PLYMOUTH YARN ${ }^{\circledR}$

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Ties: Cut 3 strands each of MC and CC, each 40 " long. Attach the 6 strands to the earflap cast on edge by folding in half and looping through. Make a braid that is 16 " or desired length. Knot the end and trim. Repeat this for the other earflap.
Weave in all ends.

## Mittens

With double pointed needles and MC, use the long tail cast on method, and cast on $28,(32,36)$ sts. Join in the round, being careful not to twist. Place marker. Round 1: *k2 with MC, p2 with CC; rep from * around- making sure that the non-working yarn remains in the back. Repeat this round for $2 ",\left(21 / 2,2 \frac{1}{2}\right)$. Then, work in st st- alternating 2 rounds MC and 2 rounds CC now and throughout. Work 4 rounds.

## Thumb Gusset

Round 1: k13, $(15,17)$ sts, pm, (kf\&b)2x, pm, k13, $(15,17)$ sts. ( 2 sts increased)
Round 2: knit across all sts, slipping markers.
Round 3: knit to marker, $\mathrm{sl} \mathrm{m}, \mathrm{ml}$, knit to $\mathrm{m}, \mathrm{m} 1$, sl marker, k to end of round. Repeat these 2 rounds until there are $12,(12,14)$ sts for the thumb.
Next Round: $k$ to 1 st before $m$, $k f \& b$, remove marker, place the $12,(12,14)$ thumb sts onto scrap yarn, remove marker, $k f \& b, k$ to end of round.
$28,(32,36)$ sts.
Cont to work in st st until mitten measures $51 / 2 ",(7,8)$ from cast on edge, or $3 / 4$ " less than desired length.

## Decrease for Top

Round 1: *ssk, k10, $(12,14)$ sts, k2tog; rep from * once more. $24,(28,32)$ sts.
Round 2: knit across all sts.
Round 3: *ssk, k8, $(10,12)$ sts, k2tog; rep from * once more. 20, $(24,28)$ sts.
Round 4: knit across all sts.
Round 5: *ssk, k6, $(8,10)$ sts, k2tog; rep from * once more. 16, $(20,24)$ sts.
Round 6: *ssk, k4, $(6,8)$ sts, k2tog; rep from * once more. $12,(16,20)$ sts.
Round 7: *ssk, k2, $(4,6)$ sts, k2tog; rep from * once more. $8,(12,16)$ sts.

Using either 3 needle bind off or Kitchener stitch, graft the remaining sts together.
Thumb
Place the $12,(12,14)$ sts on scrap yarn onto 2 double points and join in the round, starting with correct color to match palm stripes. PM. Work in the round until thumb measures $1 \frac{1}{2} ",(13 / 4,2)$, or desired length.
Next Round: *k2tog; rep from * around. 6, $(6,7)$ sts
Next Round: $k 0,(0,1)$, *k2tog; rep from * around. Cut yarn and draw through remaining sts. Weave in all ends.

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
