

Free Pattern with Our Compliments

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GALWAY DIAMOND Hat



Approximate Finished Measurement:

Child (Ladies):

Circumference: 18.5 (21)''

Height: 9 (10)''

Materials:

Galway Worsted Diamond: 1—100g ball shown in color D10 Navy

Gauge: 20 sts = 4'' in st st on US size 7 needles;

Needles/Notions: US Size 7 – 16'' and same size dpns

(K2, p2) ribbing: Work every round as *(K2, p2); repeat from * around.

Loosely cast on 88 (100) sts. Join into the round, taking care not to twist. Place stitch marker on the needle to mark beginning of the round. Work in the round as follows.

Work in (k2, p2) ribbing until total length is about 8 (10)'' ending with a WS row.

Top Shaping:

Round 1: (K2, p2tog) around.

Round 2 & 3: (K2, p1) around.

Round 4: (K2tog, p1) around.

Round 5 & 6: (K1, p1) around.

Round 7: (K2tog) around.

Round 8: (K2tog) around, ending k1, if needed. Cut yarn and pull end through remaining sts.

Pull up tight and anchor. Weave in all ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, cont= continue, dec= decrease, inc= increase, m= marker, pm= place marker, psso= pass slipped stitch over, p = purl, rem= remain(ning), rep= repeat, RS= right side, sl = slip, sm = slip marker, SSK = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tbl = through back loop, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side, yo = yarn over
