

Free Pattern with Our Compliments

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**ELINA from Nako
Asymmetric Shawl**



Size: Approx. 80” x 20”

Materials:

Elina from Nako: 3 —100g balls, shown in color 2787

Bonfire

Gauge: 5 sts =1” over garter st.

Needles: 24” Size US 8

Begin:

Cast on 4 sts.

Set up row 1: K1, Kf&b, knit to end of row.

Set up row 2: K1, k2tog, Kf&b, k1.

Begin Pattern:

Row 1(RS): K1, Kf&b, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Row 2: Knit to last 2 sts, Kf&b, k1.

Repeat rows 1 & 2-- 4 more times for a total of 10 rows (5 ridges), ending with a row 2 and an even number of sts. Work the next RS row as follows to make an eyelet row:

Eyelet Row 1(RS) (work over an even number of sts): K1, *(yo, k2tog); repeat from * to last st, end k1.

Eyelet Row 2: Knit to last 2 sts, Kf&b, k1.

Work rows 1 & 2 of pattern 5 more times. Work Eyelet Row 1 & Eyelet Row 2. Continue working these 12 rows until almost out of yarn, ending with a WS row, when ready to bind off.

Abbreviations: K = knit, yo = yarn over, st(s) = stitch(es), kf&b – knit into the front and the back of the stitch (an increase), k2tog = knit 2 sts together.

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Next row: Work the picot bind off as follows: or work a regular stretchy bind off if preferred.

Picot Bind Off(RS): *(Cast on 2 sts, bind off 5 sts); repeat from * until less than 5 sts remain. Bind off remaining sts. Weave in all ends. Block out.

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
