

SONNET Asymmetric Scarf



Size: Approx. 58" x 12.5 deep"

Materials:

Sonnet: 1 – 100g skein, shown in color 86 Sage

Gauge: 24 sts = 4" over garter st on size 5 needles.

Needles: 24" size US 5.

Begin:

Cast on 4 sts.

Set up row 1: K1, Kf&b, knit to end of row.

Set up row 2: K1, k2tog, Kf&b, k1.

Begin Pattern:

Row 1(RS): K1, Kf&b, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Row 2: Knit to last 2 sts, Kf&b, k1.

Repeat rows 1 & 2 -- 4 more times for a total of 10 rows (5 ridges), ending with a row 2 and an even number of sts. Work the next RS row as follows to make an eyelet row:

Eyelet Row 1(RS) (work over an even number of sts): K1, *(yo, k2tog); repeat from * to last st, end k1.

Eyelet Row 2: Knit to last 2 sts, Kf&b, k1.

Work rows 1 & 2 of pattern 5 more times. Work Eyelet Row 1 & Eyelet Row 2.

Continue working these 12 rows until almost out of yarn, ending with a WS row, when ready to bind off.

Next row: Work the picot bind off as follows: or work a regular stretchy bind off if preferred.

Picot Bind Off (RS): *(Cast on 2 sts, bind off 5 sts, slip that one stitch that is now on the right-hand needle back onto the left-hand needle as if to purl); repeat from * until less than 5 sts remain.

Bind off remaining sts. Weave in all ends. Block out.

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ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, dec= decrease, DPNs= double pointed needles, inc= increase, k = knit, m= marker, pm= place marker, p = purl, rem= remain(ing), rep= repeat, Rnd= round, RS= right side, sl = slip, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side
