HERCAI from Nako Infinity Cowl and Matching Mitts

**Approx. Finished Measurement:****Cowl:** 8" x 50" around**Mitts:** 6" around x 7" long**Materials:****Hercal:** 2 - 100g ball, shown in color 7309

Greige Mix

Gauge: 16 sts = 4". Gauge not critical**Needles/Notions:** US Size 10, seaming needle

Option 1: A provisional cast on can also be used, then bind off the provisional sts with the last row of sts using a 3 needle bind off.

Option 2: Do not stop at 54", a much longer scarf can be knit. Bind off when desired length is reached.

Cowl:

Loosely cast on 32 sts.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: K2, *(p1, k2); repeat from * across row.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until scarf measures 50" from beginning.

Note- If just a long scarf is desired, continue knitting to desired length. There may NOT be enough yarn left however to make the mitts. Bind off loosely in pattern.

Finishing: Seam the cast on edge to the bind off edge. Weave in all ends.

Matching mitts: (make 2)

Loosely cast on 23 sts. Work in the 2 row repeat as for the Cowl until total length is 7". Bind off loosely in pattern.

Finishing: Fold mitt in half. Sew up the side seam as follows: Beginning at the bottom, sew up 4", leave the next inch open for the thumb hole, sew up the top 2". Weave in all ends.
