

Mistero Family Hats



To Fit: Baby, (Toddler, Child, Adult Small, Adult Large)

Approximate Finished Hat Circumference: 16", (17¼, 18½, 19½, 20½)

Materials:

Adriafile Mistero: 1—100g ball for all sizes. Shown in color 73

Gauge: 14 sts, 20 rows= 4" in st st on US size 10 (6mm) needles.

Needles: US Size 8 (4.5mm) 16" circular, US Size 10 (6mm) 16" circular and DPNs, 1 stitch marker.

Pattern is written for smallest size, with larger sizes in parenthesis. If only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

Begin

With smaller circular needle, long-tail cast on 56, (60, 64, 68, 72) sts.

Place marker, and join in the round, being careful not to twist sts.

Ribbing: *(K2, p2); repeat from * around.

Repeat ribbing round for 1.5, (1.5, 2, 2, 2)", ending at the marker, and decreasing or increasing on last round to achieve 55, (60, 65, 70, 70) sts on needle.

Change to larger size circular needle. Work in st st until total length is 4 (4, 4.5, 5.25, 5.75)", ending at the marker.

Top Shaping

(Switch to DPNs when there aren't enough sts to fit comfortably around.)

Round 1: *K9 (10, 11, 12, 12), k2tog; repeat from * around.

Round 2 and every even round: Knit around.

Round 3: *K8 (9, 10, 11, 11), k2tog; repeat from * around.

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Round 5: *K7(8, 9, 10, 10), k2tog; repeat from * around.

Round 7: *K6 (7, 8, 9, 9), k2tog; repeat from * around.

On odd rounds, continue working 1 less stitch before the k2tog until you have worked the round *K5, k2tog; repeat from * around. 30 sts now remain. Stop working even rounds now.

Continue working the decrease rounds only until you have worked *K1, k2tog; repeat from * around. 10 sts now remain.

Cut yarn, draw through remaining sts. Pull up tight and anchor to inside. Weave in all ends.

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
