## MiraMar Hat



**Size:**

Approx. 16 (17.5, 19)'' around to fit  
Child (Adult Small, Adult Large).

**Materials:**

**MiraMar:** 1 –100g ball, shown in color  
35 Sunbeam

**Gauge:** 20 sts = 4'' over st st.

**Needles:** 16'' circular size US 5 & 7; size  
7 dpns, 1 stitch marker.

**Begin:**

With smaller needle, loosely cast on 80  
(88, 96) sts. Place marker, and join in  
the round taking care not to twist sts.

Work in K2/p2 ribbing for 1.5''.

Change to larger needles and begin pattern:

Round 1: Knit.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: Knit.

Round 4: \*(K2tog, yo, k2); repeat from \* around.

Round 5: Knit.

Round 6: Knit.

Round 7: Knit.

Round 8: \*(K2, K2tog, yo); repeat from \* around.

Repeat rounds 1-8 until total length is about 6.5'' (7, 7.5''), ending with a round 4 or 8.

Begin decreases as follows, changing to double points when needed:

Begin on round 5 (3, 1) for sizes small, (medium, large).

Abbreviations: K = knit, p = purl, st(s) = stitch(es), k2tog = knit 2 sts together, yo =  
yarn over.

Work rounds in all stockinette stitch, eliminating the eyelet pattern for the rest of the hat.

Round 1: \*(K10, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: \*(K9, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 4: Knit.

Round 5: \*(K8, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 6: Knit.

Round 7: \*(K7, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 8: Knit.

Round 9: \*(K6, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 10: \*(K5, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 11: \*(K4, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 12: \*(K3, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 13: \*(K2, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 14: \*(K1, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

Round 15: \*(K2tog); repeat from \* around.

Cut yarn and pull through remaining sts.

Pull up tight and anchor to inside.

Weave in all ends.

Top with a pompon if desired.
