MiraMar Tassel Stitch Baby Blanket



Approximate Finished Measurements: 32" x 34.5"

Materials:

MiraMar: 4 – 100g balls, color 21 White

Gauge: Approximately 18 sts, 24 rows = 4" over pattern.

Needles/Notions: US Size 7, 24" circular needle, 2 stitch markers.

ABBREVIATION: k = knit, k2tog= knit two stitches together, pm= place marker, p = purl, p2tog = purl 2 sts together, sm = slip marker, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, yo= yarn over, RS = right side, WS = wrong side.

Loosely cast on 133 sts and work in garter st (knit every row) for 6 rows.

Begin working in pattern keeping the first 6 sts and last 6 sts of every row in garter st. Use the stitch markers to keep those sts separate.

Work the Tassel Stitch Pattern as follows across the center 121 sts, with 6 sts at each edge in garter st. The pattern as shown below contains all 133 sts, including the 6 sts kept in garter st at each side edge.

PATTERN: “Tassel Stitch”, Multiple of 6 + 1 stitches.

Row 1(RS): K6, pm, *(K4, p2); repeat from * to last 7 sts, k1, pm, k6.

Row 2(WS): K6, sm, p1, *(k2, p4); repeat from * to marker, sm, k6.

Row 3: K6, sm, *(k4, p2); repeat from * to last st before marker, k1, sm, k6.

Row 4: K6, sm, p1, *(k2, p4); repeat from * to marker, sm, k6.

Row 5: K6, sm, *place right needle between 4th and 5th stitches and draw up a loop, k1, p2, k3); repeat from * to last st before marker, k1, sm, k6.

Row 6: K6, sm, p1, *(p3, k2, p2tog); repeat from * to marker, sm, k6. On this row: the p2tog is the loop and the k1 from the previous row.

Row 7: K6, sm, k1, *(p2, k4); repeat from * to marker, sm, k6.

Row 8: K6, sm, *(p4, k2); repeat from * to last st before marker, p1, sm, k6.

Row 9: K6, sm, k1, *(p2, k4); repeat from * to marker, sm, k6.

Row 10: K6, sm, *(p4, k2); repeat from * to last st before marker, p1, sm, k6.

Row 11: K6, sm, p1, k3, *(place right needle between next 4th and 5th stitches and draw up a loop, k1, p2, k3); repeat from * to 4 sts before marker, end k1, p2, k1, sm, k6.

Row 12: K6, p1, k2, p1 *(p3, k2, p2tog); repeat from * to last 3 sts before marker, p3, sm, k6. On this row: the p2tog is the loop and the k1 from the previous row.

Repeat Rows 1-12 for pattern until piece measures about 33.5”, ending with a WS row.

Work 6 rows of garter st. Bind off knitwise. Weave in all ends.
