

BABY LLAMA 100 Cabled Hat and Cowl



Size:

Ladies medium Hat; Cowl: approx.
27" x 9"

Materials:

Baby Llama 100: 1 – 100g skein for
each garment, shown in color 103
Grey Frost Heather

If making both pieces, make the hat
first and use remaining yarn to make
cowl larger if desired.

Needles: 16" size US 10 plus same
size dpns for hat; 24" circular size US
10 for cowl; one stitch marker, cable
needle.

Gauge: 16 sts = 4" over pattern st.

HAT:

With 16" circular, cast on 76 sts.
Place marker and join, taking care not
to twist.

K2/p2 Ribbing: *(K2, p2); repeat
from * around.

Repeat ribbing round for 5 rounds
total, increasing 12 sts evenly around
last round: 88 sts.

Proceed in Cable Pattern as follows:

Round 1 & 2: Knit.

Round 3: *(C4B, k4); repeat from * around.

Rounds 4-6: Knit.

Round 7: *(K4, C4F); repeat from * around.

Round 8: Knit.

Repeat last 8 rounds twice more, then rounds 1-4.

Begin top shaping, changing to double points when needed.

Round 1: *(K9, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 2: Knit.

Round 3: *(K8, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Abbreviations: C4B = Slip next 2 sts onto a CN and leave at back of work; k2 then k2 from CN. C4F = Slip next 2 sts onto CN and leave at front of work; k2 then k2 from CN; K = knit, st(s) = stitch(es), k2tog = knit 2 sts together.

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Round 4: Knit.

Round 5: *(K7, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 6: Knit.

Round 7: *(K6, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 8: Knit.

Round 9: *(K5, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 10: Knit.

Round 11: *(K4, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 12: Knit.

Round 13: *(K3, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 14: *(K2, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 15: *(K1, k2tog); repeat from * around.

Round 16: *(K2tog); repeat from * around.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through remaining sts. Pull up tight and anchor. Weave in all ends.

COWL:

With 24" circular loosely cast on 96 sts. Place marker and join, taking care not to twist.

Work in k2, p2 ribbing as for hat for 6 rounds, increasing 16 sts evenly around: 112 sts.

Begin working in Cable pattern as for hat until total length is about 8", or desired length, ending at the marker, and ending with a round 1 or 5.

Next round: Knit around, decreasing 16 sts evenly around: 96 sts.

Work 6 rounds of k2/p2 ribbing.

Bind off loosely in ribbing. Weave in all ends.

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
