# ENCORE WORSTED Child's Hat, Scarf \& Mittens 


across to last st, k1.
Row 5: K1, *(Knit 5, k2tog); repeat from * across to last st, k1.
Row 7: K1, *(Knit 4, k2tog); repeat from * across to last st, k1.
Row 9: K1, *(Knit 3, k2tog); repeat from * across to last st, k1.
Row 11: K1, *(Knit 2, k2tog); repeat from * across to last st, k1.
Row 13: K1, *(Knit 1, k2tog); repeat from * across to last st, k1.
Row 14: P1, *(p2tog); repeat from * across row to last st, p1.
Cut the yarn leaving a $12^{\prime \prime}$ tail, thread it through the remaining stitches, draw up tightly and secure. Sew up side seam, reversing sewing to inside at top of ribbing so it can flip up. Weave in all ends.

## MITTENS

With smaller needles (size 5), loosely cast on $30(34,34)$ sts. Follow color pattern, working in $2 \times 2$ ribbing for $2.5(2.5,3)$ ", ending with a WS row and increasing $3(1,3)$ sts evenly across the last row: $33(35,37)$ sts. Change to larger needles (size 7) and begin working in st st, working even for 1 ", ending with a WS row. Thumb gusset:
Row 1: Knit $15(16,17)$ sts, increase in next 2 sts by knitting into the front and back of each st, knit $16(17,18)$ sts.
Row 2: Purl.
Row 3: Knit $15(16,17)$ sts, increase in next st as before, $k 2$, increase in next st as before, knit $16(17,18)$ sts.
Row 4: Purl.
Row 5: Knit $15(16,17)$ sts, increase in next st as before, k 4 , increase in next st as before, knit $16(17,18)$ sts.
Row 6: Purl.
Continue increasing as established- there will be 2 more sts each time between the 2 increases. Continue until there are $43(47,51)$ sts. Purl 1 row.
Divide for thumb:
Knit $16(17,18)$ sts, knit across next $11(13,15)$ sts. TURN, leaving $16(17,18)$ unworked. Cast on 1 st and purl back across next $12(14,16)$ sts, including the cast on st. TURN. Cast on 1 st, and knit across the next $13(15,17)$ sts, including the cast on st. These $13(15,17)$ sts are the thumb sts.
Work in st st on the thumb sts $5(7,9)$ more rows, ending with a WS row (do not change color over thumb sts).
Shape top of thumb:
Row 1: *(K1, k2tog); repeat across, ending k1 $(0,2)$ : $9(10,12)$ sts
Row 2: Purl.
Row 3: *(k2tog); repeat from * across, ending $\mathrm{k} 1(0,0): 5(5,6)$ sts. Cut yarn, thread through remaining sts, pull up tight and anchor. Sew up thumb seam.
Body of mitten:
With larger needles and RS facing, reattach yarn at base of thumb and pick up 2 sts at base of thumb. Knit across the $16(17,18)$ unworked sts of the hand. Purl back: $34(36,38)$ sts.
Work in st st until the length from the base of the thumb is $1.5(2,2.5)$ ", ending with a WS row.
Shape top of mitten:
Row 1: K1, ssk, knit 12(13, 14) sts, k2tog, ssk, knit 12(13, 14) sts, k2tog, k1.
Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.
Row 3: K1, ssk, knit $10(11,12)$ sts, k2tog, ssk, knit $10(11,12)$ sts, k2tog, k1.
Row 5: K1, ssk, knit 8(9, 10) sts, k2tog, ssk, knit 8(9, 10) sts, k2tog, k1.
Row 7: K1, ssk, knit $6(7,8)$ sts, k2tog, ssk, knit $6(7,8)$ sts, k2tog, k1.
Row 9: K1, ssk, knit $4(5,6)$ sts, k2tog, ssk, knit $4(5,6)$ sts, k2tog, k1.
Row 10: Purl. Bind off loosely.
Sew up top by folding in half. Sew up side seam. Weave in all ends.
Make second mitten the same.

## SCARF

With size 9 needles, loosely cast on $26(30,34)$ sts. Work in k2-p2 ribbing following color pattern until total length is about $45(50,55)$ ". Bind off in ribbing. Add fringe in any color. Weave in the ends.
Fringe (make 10 groups):
Cut 40 pieces into 14 " sections. Using 4 strands for each fringe section, fold in half and attach 5 groups evenly spaced along each end of scarf.
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
