Trabajos Del Peru Cabled Fingerless Gloves

Note: When working with hand-dyed yarns, for best results, alternate skeins every few rows (work 2 rows with 1 hank, 2 rows with another). Do not cut yarn, just carry up side of work.



MATERIALS: 1- 100g hank of

Trabajos del Peru.

Gauge: 4 sts = 1" on a US 9

needle over st st..

Needles: US 9 double pointed needles, or size necessary to obtain given gauge, cable needle, stitch holder.

C6B: Place 3 sts on a cable needle, hold in back, knit the next 3 sts, knit the 3 sts off of the cable needle.

C6F: Place 3 sts on a cable needle, hold in front, knit the next 3 sts, knit the 3 sts off of the cable needle.

Cable pattern (across 12 sts): Round 1-4: Knit 12. Round 5: C6B, C6F Round 6-8: Knit 12. Repeat these 8 rounds for cable pattern

RIGHT HAND: With double pointed needles loosely cast on 28 sts. Divide onto the 3 needles and join into the round, making sure not to twist the sts.

Divide as follows: Needle 1: 12 sts, needle 2: 8 sts, needle 3: 8 sts.

Work in k2-p2 cable ribbing pattern for 15 rounds. On the next round: Increase the 1st needle to 14 sts by working k2, p1, m1, p1, k2, p2, k1, m1, k1, p2.

Begin Cable ribbing and thumb:

Round 1: Needle 1: K12, p2. Needle 2: K2, p2, pm, m1, k2, m1, pm, p2. Needle 3: *(K2, p2); repeat from * across needle 3.

Round 2: Needle 1: K12, p2. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, p1, k2, p1, sm, p2. Needle 3: (K2, p2); repeat.

Round 3: Needle 1: K12, p2. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, m1, p1, k2, p1, m1, sm, p2. Needle 3: (K2, p2); repeat.

Round 4: Needle 1: K12, p2. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, p2, k2, p2., sm, p2. Needle 3: (K2, p2); repeat.

Round 5: Needle 1: C6B, C6F, p2. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, m1, p2, k2, p2, m1, sm, p2. Needle 3: (K2, p2); repeat.

Round 6: Needle 1: K12, p2. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, k1, p2, k2, p2, k1, sm, p2. Needle 3: (K2, p2); repeat.

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Round 7: Needle 1: K12, p2. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, m1, k1, p2, k2, p2, k1, m1, sm, p2. Needle 3: (K2, p2); repeat.

Round 8: Needle 1: K12, p2. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, k2, p2, k2, p2, k2, sm, p2. Needle 3: (K2, p2); repeat. Round 9 & 10: Repeat round 8.

Round 11: Needle 1: K12, p2. Needle 2: K2, p2, Place the next 10 sts on a st holder, cast on 2 sts in their place, p2. Needle 3: (K2, p2); repeat.

Round 12: Needle 1: Work round 4 of cable pattern, p2. Needle 2 & 3: (K2, p2); repeat.

Work the next round of cable pattern across the first 12 sts of needle 1, end with p2. Continue working needles 2 & 3 as established. Continue until Cables have been crossed 3 times, ending with a round 8 of the cable pattern. Next round: Work needle 1 as: K2, p1, p2tog, k2, p1, p2tog, k2, p2. Work needles 2 & 3 as established. Work k2-p2 ribbing around for 12 more rounds. Bind off in ribbing.

Divide the 10 sts from the thumb st holder as follows: Needle 1: 4 sts, needle 2: 4 sts, needle 3: 2 sts. Reattach yarn at base of thumb, pick up and purl knit 2 sts along the 2 cast on sts from when thumb was placed on holder. Place these 2 sts on the 3rd needle. Work in the round on these 12 thumb sts for 6 rounds in 2x2 ribbing. Bind off in ribbing. Weave in all ends. Fold over top cuff.

LEFT HAND: With double pointed needles loosely cast on 28 sts. Divide onto the 3 needles and join into the round, making sure not to twist the sts. Divide as follows: Needle 1: 8 sts, needle 2: 8 sts, needle 3: 12 sts. Work in k2-p2 cable ribbing pattern for 15 rounds. On the next round: Increase the 3rd needle to 14 sts by working k2, p1, m1, p1, k2, p1, k1, p1, k2, p2.

Begin Cable ribbing and thumb:

Round 1: *(K2, p2); repeat from * across needle 1. Needle 2: K2, p2, pm, m1, k2, m1, pm, p2. Needle 3: K12, p2..

Round 2: Needle 1: (K2, p2); repeat. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, p1, k2, p1, sm, p2. Needle 3: K12, p2.

Round 3: Needle 1: (K2, p2); repeat. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, m1, p1, k2, p1, m1, sm, p2. Needle 3: K12, p2.

Round 4: Needle 1: (K2, p2); repeat. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, p2, k2, p2., sm, p2. Needle 3: K12, p2.

Round 5: Needle 1: (K2, p2); repeat. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, m1, p2, k2, p2, m1, sm, p2.

Needle 3: C6B, C6F, p2.

Round 6: Needle 1: (K2, p2); repeat. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, k1, p2, k2, p2, k1, sm, p2. Needle 3: K12, p2.

Round 7: Needle 1: (K2, p2); repeat. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, m1, k1, p2, k2, p2, k1, m1, sm, p2.

Needle 3: K12, p2.

Round 8: Needle 1: (K2, p2); repeat. Needle 2: K2, p2, sm, k2, p2, k2, p2, k2, sm, p2. Needle 3: K12, p2. Round 9 & 10: Repeat round 8.

Round 11: Needle 1: (K2, p2); repeat. Needle 2: K2, p2, Place the next 10 sts on a st holder, cast on 2 sts in their place, p2. Needle 3: K12, p2.

Round 12: Needle 1 & 2: (K2, p2); repeat. Needle 3: Work round 4 of cable pattern, p2.

Continue working needles 1 & 2 as established. Work the next round of cable pattern across the first 12 sts of needle 3, end with p2. Continue until Cables have been crossed 3 times, ending with a round 8 of the cable pattern.

Next round: Work needles 1 & 2 as established, work needle 3 as: K2, p1, p2tog, k2, p1, p2tog, k2, p2. Work k2-p2 ribbing around for 12 more rounds. Bind off in ribbing.

Divide the 10 sts from the thumb st holder as follows: Needle 1: 4 sts, needle 2: 4 sts, needle 3: 2 sts. Reattach yarn at base of thumb, pick up and purl knit 2 sts along the 2 cast on sts from when thumb was placed on holder. Place these 2 sts on the 3rd needle. Work in the round on these 12 thumb sts for 6 rounds in 2x2 ribbing. Bind off in ribbing. Weave in all ends. Fold over top cuff.

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
