KUDO Crochet Scarf

Materials: Kudo- 1- 100g hank shown in color 55

Hook: Size H

Gauge: Not important

Finished Size: 4.5" wide x 56" long

Scattered Shells Pattern Stitch:

Row 1: 2 dc in the 4th ch from hook (half shell), * skip 2 chs, 1 sc in next ch, skip 2 chs, 5 dc in next st (shell), skip 2 chs, sc in next ch, repeat from * ending skip 2 chs, half shell in last ch, ch 1, turn.

Row 2: Sc in the 1st stitch, * work a shell in the next sc, sc in the center stitch of the next shell, repeat from *, ending with a shell in the next sc, sc in the top of the turning chain, ch 3, turn.

Row 3: 2 dc in the 1st sc (half shell), * sc in the center stitch of the next shell, 1 shell in the next sc, rep from *, ending with 1 sc in the center stitch of the next shell, 2 dc in the last sc, ch 1, turn.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 for the pattern.

Scarf:

Using H hook chain 25 and work rows 1-3 of pattern stitch. Continue in pattern stitch working rows 2 and 3 until scarf measures approx. 56". Fasten off. Weave in ends.
