

ANGORA

To Fit: Newborn, (3, 6, 9) months
Approx. Circumference: 12", (14, 16, 18)

Materials:

Angora: 2—10G balls, color 711, Blue

Gauge: 5 sts = 1" in st st on size 8 knitting needles

Needles: US Size 6 & 8 double points, stitch marker

Pattern is written for smallest size, with larger sizes in parenthesis. If one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

With size 6 double points, Cast on 60, (70, 80, 90) sts. Join in the round, being careful not to twist.

Place stitch marker.

Work in 1x1 ribbing for 7 rounds. Switch to size 8 knitting needles and st st.

Knit 2 rounds.

Increase Round 1: *k6, (7, 8, 9), m1; rep from *

70, (80, 90, 100) sts. Knit 3 rounds.

Increase Round 2: *k7, (8, 9, 10), m1; rep from *

80, (90, 100, 110) sts.

Work in st st for 1 ½".

Decrease Round 1: *k3, k2tog; rep from *

64, (72, 80, 88) sts.

Knit 3 rounds.

Decrease Round 2: *k2, k2tog; rep from *

48, (54, 60, 66) sts.

Knit 3 rounds.

Decrease Round 3: *k1, k2tog; rep from *

32, (36, 40, 44) sts.

Knit 3 rounds.

Decrease Round 4: *k2tog; rep from *

16, (18, 20, 22) sts.

Decrease Round 5: *k2tog; rep from *

8, (9, 10, 11) sts.

Decrease Round 6: k0, (1, 0, 1), *k2tog; rep from *

4, (5, 5, 6) sts.

Work 1 ½" I-cord on these sts.

Cut yarn. Draw through remaining sts.

Pull tightly. Knot the I-cord if desired. Weave in all ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS: BO=bind off, C6F= slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold to front, k3, k3 from cable needle, dec = decrease, inc = increase, k = knit, pssso= pass slip stitch over, p = purl, RS= right side, sl = slip, SSK = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tbl = through back loop, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side, yo = yarn over, wyif = with yarn in front, wyib = with yarn in back.
