

HACIENDO
Garter Stitch Scarf



SCARF:

Size: Approx. 6" wide and 52" long

Materials: 2 hanks Haciendo – 1 each of 2 colors

Needles: Size 17

Gauge: 9 sts = 4" over garter st; but not critical.

Garter st with all ends- or "fringe" along one side only.

Note: Count the number of rows for each stripe so they are equal.

With size 17 needles, and Color A, loosely cast on 13 sts. Mark the 1st row as the right side.

Work in garter st(knit every row) for 4", ending with a WS row. Cut Color A leaving 8" tail.

**Attach color B leaving an 8" tail; and continue in garter St. Work for 4", ending with a WS row.

Cut yarn leaving an 8" tail. Attach color A leaving an 8" tail; and continue in garter St.

Work for 4", ending with a WS row. Cut Color A, leaving an 8" tail.

Repeat from ** until desired Length. End with a stripe of Color A. Bind off loosely. Weave in the cast on and bind off tails only. Knot the other tails to their alternate color counterpart using an overhand knot so they fall in the same direction. Tie a small knot near the end of each tail, or at the same length point- about 5" out. Trim each tail pair to about 5.5-6" or desired length.

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
