

**WORSTED MERINO SUPERWASH KETTLE DYED  
Circle Scarf**



**Size:** 56” circumference 7” wide, after blocking

**Materials:** 1—200G skeins, color 1005 of WMSW Kettledyed

**Gauge:** 20 sts, 28 rows= 4” in st st on size 7 needles

**Needles:** Size 7-32” circular, stitch marker

**Stitch Pattern** (Multiple of 5 sts)

1st Round (right side): \*K4, P1; rep from \* to end

Rep 1st round 4 more times.

6th Round: P5, \*K4, P6; rep from \* to last 5 sts, K4, P1.

7th Round: As 1st Row.

Rep the last 2 rounds twice more.

12th and 13th Round: as 1st Round

Rep the last 2 rounds once more.

16th Round: \*K4, P6; rep from \* to end.

17th Round: As 1st Round.

Rep the last 2 rounds once more, then 16th Round again.

Rep these 20 rounds for stitch pattern.



Cast on 280 sts. Join in the round, being careful not to twist. Place stitch marker. Work 10 rows in garter stitch. Work in **stitch pattern** for 5”. Work 10 rows in garter stitch. Bind off all sts very loosely- use 1 or 2 sizes larger needle if necessary. Weave in all ends. Block.

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
