

Kudo Scarf J



Size: Approx. 5" x 72"

Materials: 1- 100g hank of Kudo-shown in color 47.

Needles: Size US 9.

Butterfly Pattern Stitch

Cast on 21 sts. Knit 2 rows.

Begin Butterfly Pattern Stitch as follows:

Row 1 (RS): K3, (pm), wyif slip 5 sts, k5, wyif slip 5 sts, (pm), k3.

Row 2 and all even # rows: K3, purl to the last 3 sts, k3.

Rows 3 and 5: Repeat row 1.

Row 7: K5, *[insert needle between the 3 loose strands, yarn over needle and draw loop up (this will gather 3 strands together); knit the next st and pass the loop over the knit st, k9]; repeat from * ending the second repeat with k5, instead of k9.

Row 9: K8, wyif slip 5, k8.

Rows 11 and 13: Repeat row 9.

Row 15: K 10, insert needle between the 3 loose strands, yarn over needle and draw up a loop (this will gather 3 strands together), knit the next st and pass the loop over the knit st, K 10.

Row 16: K3, purl to last 3 sts, k3.

Repeat rows 1-16 to desired length.

Knit 2 rows. Bind off. Weave in ends. Block out.
