

TARIA TWEED Long Buttoned Cowl



Size: Approx 12" x 22"
Gauge: 3 stitches per inch
Materials: 2 hanks Taria Tweed, size 10 needles;
3 buttons.

Cowl is knit side to side. Can be buttoned 2 ways.

Pattern:

Loosely cast on 44 sts.

Work in ribbing pattern as follows:

Row 1(RS): K4, *(p4, k4); repeat from * to last 4 sts, end k4.

Row 2(WS): P4, *(k4, p4); repeat from * to last 4 sts, end p4.

Repeat these 2 rows for 6 rows total.

Next row: Begin buttonholes:

RS row: K4, p2, yo, p2tog, k4, p4, k4, p2, yo, p2tog, k4, p4, k4, p2, yo, p2tog, k4.

Next row: Work as for row 2.

Row 8 rows in ribbing.

Work a side buttonhole:

RS row: K4, p2, yo, p2tog, rib to end of row.

Next row: Work as for row 2.

Row 8 rows in ribbing.

Work another side buttonhole as before. Continue in ribbing until desired length has been reached - or 22", ending with a WS row.

Bind off in ribbing on RS row. Sew on 3 buttons at the bind off end - centered 1.5" in from edge.



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
