

## GRANDE GLOW

### Neck Scarf



**Length: 30"**

**Width at widest point: 7 ½"**

**Materials: Baby Alpaca Grande Glow:**

**1—100g skein, color 9402, Grey**

**Gauge:** 14 sts, 20 rows= 4" in st st on size 10½ needles, 20 sts = 5 ½" in brioche stitch on size 10½ needles.

**Needles:** US size 10 ½ straight knitting needles, Stitch marker

#### **Brioche Stitch**

**Foundation Row:** \*sl1 with yarn in front, bring yarn to back, yo, k1; rep from \*.

**Row 1:** \*sl1 with yarn in front, bring yarn to back, yo, k2tog; rep from \*

Repeat Row 1 for pattern.

Cast on 5 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** k1, \*p1, k1; rep from \*

**Row 2:** p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \*

Repeat these 2 rows until piece measures 4", ending with a WS Row.

**Increase Row (RS):** Rib 5 sts, cast on 2 sts.

**Next Row:** p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \*

**Increase Row (RS):** rib 5 sts, m1 knitwise, p1, k1.

**Next Row:** knit the knits, purl the purls

**Increase Row (RS):** rib 5 sts, m1 purlwise, rib to end of row.

**Next Row:** knit the knits, purl the purls

Repeat the last 4 rows until there are 17 sts on needle.

**Pattern Setup Row (RS):** Rib 5 sts, place marker, work

in brioche stitch across the remaining sts.

Continue to work the first 5 sts of RS rows in ribbing, and the remaining sts in brioche stitch. When piece measures 26" from cast on edge, end with a WS Row.

**Decrease Row (RS):** rib 5 sts, sl marker, \*p1, k2tog; rep from \* across row. 17 sts.

**Next Row:** p1, \*k1, p1; rep from \* across.

**Decrease Row (RS):** rib 4 sts, k2tog, rib to end of row.

**Next Row:** knit the knits and purl the purls.

Repeat the last 2 rows until there are 7 sts, ending with a WS Row.

Bind off 2 sts, rib to end of row.

Work in ribbing for 4" more. Bind off all sts in rib. Weave in all ends.

Abbreviations: K = knit, p = purl, st st = stockinette st, k3tog = knit 3 sts together, p2tog = purl 2 sts together, st(s) – stitch(es), yo = yarn over, pssso = pass slipped st over, sl = slip; wyif = with yarn in front; pm = place marker.
