BABY ALPACA GRANDE TWEED Hooded Neckwarmer



To Fit: Adult Approximate Measurements: 22 ½" long x 22" circumference

Materials:

Baby Alpaca Grande Tweed: 3—100G skeins, color 2726 Orange

Gauge: 14 sts, 20 rows= 4" in st st on size 10 ½ needles, 4 sts= 1" in pattern stitch, slightly stretched.

Needles: US Size 10 ½- 16" circular needle, cable needle, stitch marker, stitch holder.

Pattern Stitch (Multiple of 6 sts + 2) Round 1: p2, *C2B, C2F, p2; rep from * across. Round 2: p2, *k4, p2; rep from * across. Repeat these 2 rounds for pattern.

Cast on 86. Join in the round, being careful not to twist. Place marker. Begin working in pattern stitch. When piece measures 8" from cast on edge, decrease 8 sts evenly across.

78 sts. Work in st st now and throughout. Work 2 rounds.

<u>Decrease Round:</u> ssk, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. Work one round plain.

Repeat last 2 rounds twice more. 72 sts.

<u>Divison:</u> You will now be working in rows and not in the round for the remainder of the hood.

(RS): Knit 72 sts, remove marker, turn.

Cont in st st in rows until hood measures 20 ½" from cast on edge, end having worked a RS Row.

Shape Hood (WS): p36 sts, turn and place the other sts onto a holder.

(RS) Bind off 2 sts, knit to end of row. Purl one row.

Repeat the last 2 rows 3 times more. Bind off all sts on next row.

Reattach yarn to WS of sts on holder and bind off 2 sts, purl to end of row.

Knit one row.

(WS) Bind off 2 sts, purl to end of row. Repeat the last 2 rows 2 times more. Bind off all sts on next row. Sew hood seam.

<u>Rib Edging:</u> With RS facing, Pick up and knit 104 sts along hood opening. Join in the round and place marker. Work in Pattern Stitch for 1". Bind off all sts in rib. Block lightly and weave in all ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS: C2B= slip 1 st to cable needle and hold to back, k1, k1 from cable needle, C2F= slip 1 st to cable needle and hold to front, k1, k1 from cable needle, dec = decrease, inc = increase, k = knit, pm= place marker, psso = pass slip stitch over, p = purl, RS= right side, sl = slip, SSK = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tbl = through back loop, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side, yo = yarn over, wyif = with yarn in front, wyib = with yarn in back.
