

Linen Concerto Scarf



Materials: 3 balls of Linen Concerto (50g color 73

Needles: Set of size US 7 circular needles or size to obtain gauge, 4 Stitch Markers.

Gauge:

16 sts and 22 rows =4” on US size 7 in stockinette stitch

Cast on 14 sts.

Row 1: K4, pm, k2, pm, k2, pm, k2, pm k4.

Row 2: K4, purl to last 4 sts, K4 (keeping markers in place).

Row 3: (Increase Row) K4, sm, yo, knit to marker, yo, sm, k2, sm, yo, knit to next marker, yo, sm, k4.

Row 4: K4, purl to last 4 sts, k4.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 until the center 2 st vein measures 17” (approx. 194 sts).

Knit 6 rows garter stitch ending on a WS row.

Bind off Picot Edge as follow:

Cast off 4 sts as usual. Slip 1 st from your RH needle to LH needle. Using cable cast on, cast on 2 sts. Cast off 6 sts. * Repeat this method* until all sts are cast off.

Finishing:

Weave in ends.

Soak the garment in cold water and with a sweater soap, if desired. Leave in water for at least 30 minutes to get the water all the way to the core of the yarn. Place water and scarf in washing machine and using the spin cycle, spin for approximately 3-5 minutes. Lay flat on a blocking board, or a towel. Pin out to show the picot edge. Let dry.

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
