

## CLEO Medallion Necklace and Sandals - Crochet



### One Size Fits Most

**Materials:** 3-50G hanks Cleo; we used 1 each of Red, Aqua, Navy

**Hook/Notions:** #F Crochet Hook, 3 - 2" Plastic Rings

### SANDALS & MEDALLION:

BEGIN BY CROCHETING INTO RING:

Round 1: With F hook, and Color #1, create a slip knot onto hook, then SC into the ring 49 times. Join with Slip Stitch into top of first SC. Cut yarn #1.

Round 2: With Color #2, Ch 5. Working into the SC from previous round:

(\*DC in next 3 SC, HDC in next 3 SC), SC in next 2 SC, (\*\*HDC in next 3, DC in next 3), Ch 1, TC in next SC, CH 1,

repeat \*, SC in next 21 SC, repeat \*\*. Ch 1, join with Slip Stitch into 4<sup>th</sup> Ch of Ch 5. Cut yarn #2.

Round 3: With Color #3, Ch 3, 2 SC in Ch 1 space, SC in next 14 SC, 2 SC in Ch 1 space, DC in TC, 2 SC in Ch 1 space, SC in next 16 SC,

FOR SANDALS: Chain 10, then SC in next 16 SC

FOR MEDALLION: DC in same SC, then SC in next 16 SC

For both SANDALS & MEDALLIONS:

2 SC in CH 1 space, join with Slip Stitch to top of CH 3. Cut yarn #3.

Create String Ties:

With F Hook & Color #3, start with slip knot, leaving a 2" tail, and firmly Chain 100 for Sandals, or 75 for Medallion.

Attach: RIGHT SIDE FACING, SC into corner DC from last row worked. SC in next 16 SC, SC in DC, Chain additional 100 for Sandals (75 for Medallion). Cut yarn leaving 2" tail, pull through last stitch.

For each tie: Cut 8" piece of Color of #3. Fold in half and pull half way through the last stitch of the long chain.

Take the 2" tail with the four additional strands, and knot them all together right at the point you attached the folded 8" piece. Trim edges evenly to 1.25 - 1.5 inches as desired. Repeat for other end of long chain.

ABBREVIATIONS: CH= chain, cont= continue, DC= double crochet, dec = decrease, inc = increase, k = knit, m= marker, m1- make one, pm= place marker, pssso = pass slip stitch over, p = purl, RS= right side, SC= single crochet, sl = slip, SSK = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tbl = through back loop, TC= triple crochet, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side, yo = yarn over, wyif = with yarn in front, wyib = with yarn in back,
