

Maciel: Glovettes



SIZE: one size.

MATERIALS: 1 ball of Maciel by Maria Diaz **GAUGE**: 20 sts. to 4 in. on US size 8 needle

NEEDLE SIZE: US size 8(5mm) double pointed needles,

and 2 stitch markers.

STITCH PATTERNS:

1x1 Rib Stitch: Knit 1 stitch, Purl 1 stitch

Garment Stitch-(Crossed 2x1 Rib Stitch):

(worked in the round over a multiple of 3 sts+1)

Row 1: P1, *Knit through the back loop of the second stitch on the left needle, then knit through the front of the first stitch, and drop them both from the needle at the same time, P1*

Row 2: K1, *Purl the second stitch on the left needle, then purl the first stitch, and drop them both from the needle at the same time. K1*

Repeat these 2 rows to create pattern.

Make 1: With point of left-hand needle, from back to front pick up bar running between last st on right-hand needle and first stitch on left-hand needle, and knit thru back of this stitch just created.

Directions for Mitten:

The mittens are made with 5 double pointed needles – in order create a circular or tubular mitten.

Cast on 52 stitches onto one of the needles

Divide the stitches evenly onto 4 needles..

Begin knitting the 1x1 Rib Stitch. For 2".

Next work in Crossed 2x1 Rib for 2.5".

Thumb Gusset:

To create the thumb, k25 sts, pm, (kf&b)2 times, finish round. Next round k26, sm, m1, work in pattern to next m, m1. Work this increase every round until you have a thumb of $2\frac{1}{2}$ " and 24 stitches between markers, in total. Cast off these 24 sts on the next round.

Next round connect all 52 sts again and continue working in Crossed 2x1 Rib until piece measures 5" from beginning. Bind off loosely.

Finishing:

Weave in ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS: cn= cable needle, dpn=double pointed needles, K = knit, k2tog = knit 2 sts together, m=marker, pm=place marker, p = purl, sm=slip marker, st(s) = stitch(es), RS = right side, sl=slip, st(s)=stitch(es), WS = wrong side.
