## COLCA CANYON Cowl



Finished Size: 22"diameter, 8" length.

Materials: 2 balls Colca Canyon, shown in color red #1112

**Needles:** Size US 17 circular needles *or size to obtain gauge.* 

1 stitch marker, 1 cable needle, Size 9 mm crochet hook, 1 tapestry needle.

**Gauge:** 9 sts = 4" on US size 17 in Stockinette

## **DIRECTIONS**

Loosely cast on 45 sts. Join for working in the round being careful not to twist your stitches. Place marker. Work 1 round of purl. Work 4 rounds of knit (st st in the round). Next work these 2 steps:

- 1. \*K3, sl 3 sts to cable needle, k3, k3 sts from cable needle; rep from \* to end.
- 2. Work 6 rounds of st st

Work these 2 steps 2 more times.

Bind off as follows:

K1, \*drop 1 st, yo, bind off 1 st over the yo. Bind off 8; rep from \* until 2 sts remaining. Drop 1, yo, k1, bind off over yo.

Drawstring: With crochet hook, chain for 40".

## **Finishing:**

Run the dropped sts from the bind off round to the bottom of the cowl.

With drawstring, weave it in and out of the eyelets created from yo's and into the running st. Tie ends of drawstring. Weave in all ends.

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
