TORIA Lace Scarf



Finished Size: 7" x 80" (not including fringe)
Materials: 2 – 25g balls of Toria, color #53
Needles: Size US 6 needles or size to obtain gauge.
1 tapestry needle.

Gauge: 26 sts and 30 rows=4" on US size 6 over lace pattern.

Lace Pattern: (11 sts +2)

Row 1: (RS) k1, *k2tog, k3, yo, k1, yo, k3, SKPO; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 and every alternate row: Purl

Row 3 and 5: Work as Row 1.

Row 7: K1, *k2tog, k2, yo, k3, yo, k2, SKPO, rep

from * to last st, k1.

Row 9: k1, *k2tog, k1, yo, k5, yo, k1, SKPO, rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 11: K1, *(k2tog, yo, k1) twice, yo, SKPO, k1, yo, SKPO, rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 13: Work as for Row 11.

Row 15: Work as for Row 9.

Row 17: Work as for Row 7.

Row 18: purl.

Rep these 18 rows for pattern.

DIRECTIONS

Cast on 46 sts loosely and work in Lace Pattern.

When work measures approximately 80" from cast on edge end with row 18.

Cast off all sts loosely.

Fringe:

Cut lengths of yarn each about 12" long, fold 3 strands tog in half and draw loops thru first st at one end of scarf. Draw ends of strands thru loop and tighten. Rep this fringe work every ½" along each end of scarf. Trim ends.

Finishing:

With tapestry needle, weave in ends.

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
