

## Colorando

### Checkerboard Running Stitch Scarf



**Finished size:** about 65" x 8" (blocked).

**Materials:** Colorando (50g) 3 balls, shown in color # 603

**Gauge:** 10 sts, 20 rows= 4" in Garter Stitch on US size 10 needle, *or size to obtain gauge.*

**Needles:** US size 10  
tapestry needle.

#### Pattern Sequence:

[Work in Garter St. for 3".

Next row: K2, \*yo twice, k1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k1, yo twice, k2.

Next row: K2, \*drop yo's from previous row, k1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k1, drop yo's, k2.]

Repeat from [ to ] for pattern.

#### DIRECTIONS

CO 32 sts.

Follow Pattern Sequence described above until piece is approx. 61".

End with Garter St. for 3".

Last row, k10, drop 1, k10, drop 1, k10.

Bind off Row-when you encounter the st where you dropped a st, pick up running thread with LH needle and ktbl. Bind off as usual.

Run the dropped sts to cast on edge.

#### Finishing:

Weave in all ends. Lightly steam the entire scarf with a warm iron. Hang for at least 1 hour for the running sts to relax.



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Abbreviations: approx.=approximately, garter stitch=knit every row, k = knit, rep = repeat, tbl=thru back loop, yo = yarn over
