## SAHARA Tilting Block Cowl



Approximate Measurements:
8", (14) wide x $371 / 2 "$ circumference

## Materials:

Sahara: 3, (4)-50g balls, color 1198 Silver
Gauge: 17 sts, 32 rows $=4$ " in tilting block pattern on size 8 ( 5 mm ) knitting needle.
Needles: US Size 8-32" circular needle, stitch marker.
Tilting Block Pattern (Multiple of 16 sts)
Rounds 1, 3, 5, 7: *(Ssk, yo) $4 \mathrm{x}, \mathrm{k} 8$; rep from * around. Rounds 2, 4, 6, 8: *K8, p8; rep from * around.
Rounds 9, 11, 13, 15: *K8, (yo, k2tog)4x; rep from * around.
Rounds 10, 12, 14, 16: *P8, k8; rep from * around.
Repeat rounds 1-16 for pattern stitch.
Pattern is written for smallest size, with larger sizes in parenthesis. If only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. Shown in the larger size.

## Begin

CO 160 sts. Join in the round, being careful not to twist. Pm. Work 64, (112) rounds of Tilting Block Pattern (4, (7) full repeats of the pattern stitch), following either the written or the charted instructions (on reverse).

Note: When working the charted instructions, work all rounds from right to left. BO all sts on next round in k. Weave in all ends. Block.
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ABBREVIATIONS: $B O=$ bind off, $C O=$ cast on, $m=$ marker, $p m=$ place marker, $p s s o=$ pass slipped stitch over, $p=$ purl, $R S=$ right side, sl = slip, SSK = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st $\mathrm{st}=$ stockinette st, tbl = through back loop, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side, yo = yarn over, wyif = with yarn in front, wyib = with yarn in back.

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
