

BABY BEENZ Corkscrew Hat



Sizes: Infant (Toddler, Child)

Approximate Measurements: 14(16, 19)''hat circumference, unstretched

Materials:

Baby Beenz: 1—100g ball, color #167

Gauge: 18 sts, 24 rows = 4'' using US size 8 (5 mm) needles in st st.

Needles: US size 8 (5 mm) 16'' circular needle, and US size 8 (5 mm) double pointed needles, stitch marker, tapestry needle.

Twin Rib: (multiples of 6)

Round 1: *k3, p3; rep from * to end

Round 2: *k1, p1; rep from * to end

Repeat rounds 1 and 2 for pattern.

Begin

Cast on 78(84, 96) sts. Place marker. Join together to work in the round being sure not to twist sts.

Follow Twin Rib Pattern defined above until pc measures approx. 3(3.5, 4)'' (or desired rib band height).

Change to St St (knit all rounds in the round). Decrease 1(0, 5) sts evenly across first round.

When St St measures 2(2, 2.5)'' shape crown. (Change to dpn's when necessary.)

Round 1: *K5, k2tog; rep from * to end.

Rounds 2, 4, 6, 8: Knit

Round 3: *K4, k2tog; rep from * to end.

Round 5: *k3, k2tog; rep from * to end.

Round 7: *k2, k2tog; rep from * to end.

Round 9: *K1, k2tog; rep from * to end.

Round 10: *k2tog; rep from * to end.

Round 11: *k2tog; rep from * to end.

Break yarn. Thread tapestry needle and slip all rem sts onto thread. Weave end to the inside of hat.

Corkscrew Tassels:

Very loosely, but evenly, cast on 20 sts.

Row 1: (k1, ktbl, k1) in each st across the row.

Row 2: bind off purlwise.

Repeat 7 more times, or the desired # of tassels.

Attach each tassel to crown of the hat. (Easiest done immediately after each one is finished.) Weave in all ends.

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
