

JUST FUR KICKS Wrap



Approximate Measurements:
43” circumference, 6.5” tall
(as shown)

Materials:

Just Fur Kicks:

2—100g skeins, color 204 Moss

Gauge: 10 sts = 4” using US
size 15 (10 mm) needles.

Needles: US size 15 (10mm) straight
knitting needles,
Accessories: 8 locking stitch markers,
tapestry needle, 2 yds or 2” double
faced silk ribbon, thread and sewing
needle.

Pattern Notes:

This simple wrap is knit from
side to side in garter stitch with
tapered ends and slight shaping

for the back. Ribbon is sewn on to the ends for the bow. I suggest using locking marker to mark changes in shaping, but they are optional.

Begin

With a flexible tape measure, measure around your shoulders, about where you will be wearing the wrap. Your finished measurement is 2 to 3 inches shorter than this measurement.

Divide this measurement into 3rds.

CO 12 sts and work in garter stitch.

KFB into the first stitch of the next 10 rows. (22 sts).

Place marker (pm) into the sts at each end. Measure this length. (approx.. 3”).

When piece measures 1/3 of the total measurement, KFB into the first st of the next 2 rows. PM into the sts at each end. (24 sts)

When piece measures 2/3 of the total measurement, k2tog at the beginning the next 2 rows. PM in the sts at each end (22 sts).

When piece measures 3” less than the total measurement, k2tog at the beg of the next 10 rows. (12 sts).

Bind off and weave in all ends.

BOW:

Cut ribbon in half on the diagonal. Fold the straight edge under twice, press and sew. Sew the folded ends to the cast on and bound off ends of the wrap.

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
