

**BABY ALPACA AIRE:  
Ribbed Cowl**



**Finished Measurement:**

9 x 22" approximately

**Materials:** 1 – 100g ball Baby Alpaca Aire,  
tapestry needle.

**Needles:** US size 9 (4.5 mm) circular (16")  
needle *or size to obtain gauge.*

**Gauge:** 16 sts and 22 rows =4" on US size 9  
needle

**Garter Rib Pattern:**

(multiples of 4 sts in the round)

**Round 1:** knit

**Round 2:** \*k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

**These 2 rounds create Garter Rib pattern.**

**Directions:**

Cast on 92 sts. Join in the round being sure not to twist sts. Work 2 rounds of purl.

Change to working in Garter Rib pattern as defined above.

When piece measures 8.5" from cast on edge, work 2 rounds in purl.

Bind off loosely purlwise. Weave in all ends.

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Abbreviations: K = knit, k1/p1=knit 1 stitch/ purl 1 stitch, k3tog=knit 3 together, p = purl, p3tog=purl 3 together, st(s) – stitch(es).
