

BABY ALPACA CHERISH **Cowl**



Approximate Finished Measurements:
6 ¾" long x 19" circumference

Materials:

Baby Alpaca Cherish:

1—50g ball, color 21 Boysenberry

Gauge: 20 sts, 28 rows= 4" in st st on US Size 7 (4.5mm) needles,
18 sts= 4" in Lucina Shell Pattern on US Size 7 (4.5mm) needles.

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5mm) 16" circular needle, 4 St markers (m).

Work either the charted or the written directions for the Lucina Shell Pattern. If working the chart, work all rounds from right to left.

Lucina Shell Pattern

(Multiple of 9 sts + 3, inc'd on rounds 1-6)

Round 1: K2, *yo, k8, yo, k1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Round 2: P3, *k8, p3; rep from * around.

Round 3: K3, *yo, k8, yo, k3; rep from * around.

Round 4: P3, *p1, k8, p4; rep from * around.

Round 5: K3, *k1, yo, k8, yo, k4; rep from * around.

Round 6: P3, *p2, k8, p5; rep from * around.

Round 7: K3, *k2, k4togtbl, k4tog, k5; rep from * around.

Round 8: P all sts.

Rep these 8 rounds for pattern st.

Begin

Long-tail CO 90 sts, placing a m as follows: after 21 sts, after 24 sts, after 21 sts, and after the last 24 sts—this last m will m the beg of the round. Join in the round, being careful not to twist.

Border Round 1: K all sts.

Border Round 2: P all sts.

Rep these 2 rounds 2 times more, then work Border Round 1 once again (7 rounds total have been worked).

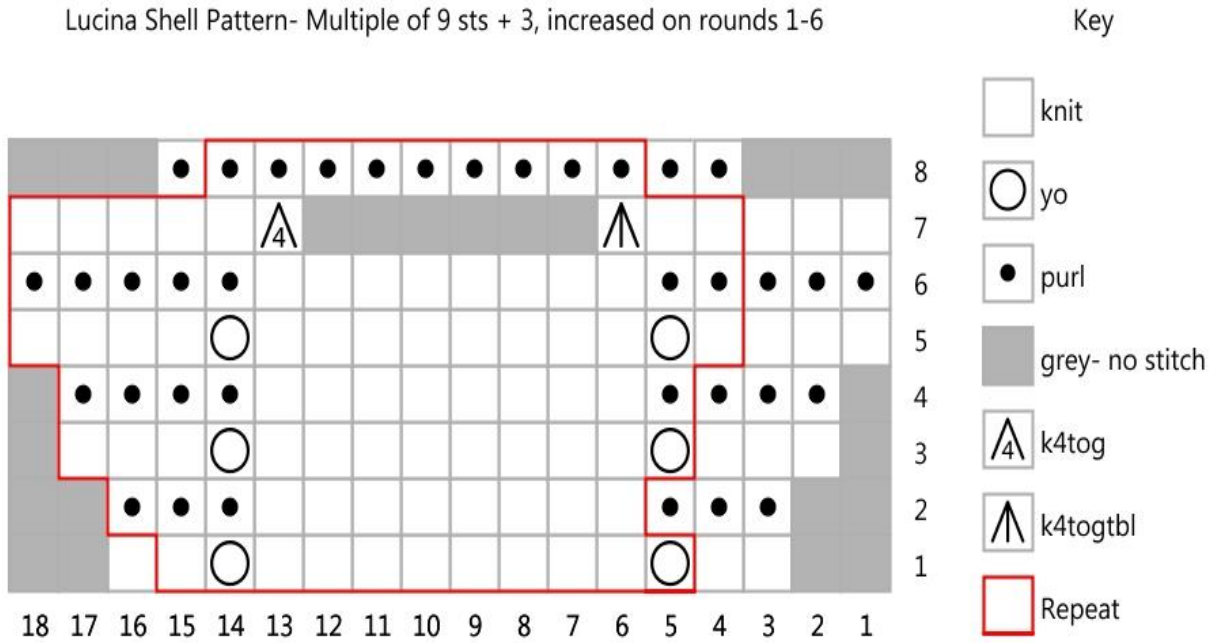
Pattern Round: *Work in Lucina Shell Pattern to m, sl m, k to next m, sl m; rep from * once more.

Rep this last round, while working in established Lucina Shell pattern, until 5 total rep (40 rounds) of the Lucina Shell Pattern have been worked. Work the border rounds for 6 rounds (starting with border round 1) and BO all sts in k loosely on next round. Weave in all ends and block.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, inc= increase, k= knit, m= marker, p = purl, rep= repeat(ing), RS= right side, sl = slip, SSK = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tbl= through back loop, tog = together, yo = yarn over
