

ENCORE WORSTED Chevron Tube Cowl



Approximate Measurements: 10 3/4" wide x 31" circumference

Materials:

Encore Worsted:

1—100G ball each of color 687 (MC) Green and color 175 (CC) Rust

Gauge: 16 sts, 20 rows= 4" in st st on US Size 10 (6mm) knitting needles,

Needles: US Size 10 (6mm) 24" circular needle, spare circular needle in similar size, St marker (m), scrap yarn, crochet hook size 6mm.

Pattern Stitch (Multiple of 17 sts) Round 1: *Kf&b, k6, sl1, k2tog, psso, k6, kf&b; rep from *. Round 2: K all sts. Rep these 2 rounds for pattern stitch.

Begin

With scrap yarn and crochet hook, chain 85 sts. Cut scrap yarn. With MC and circular needle, pick up and k 85 sts along the chain. Place m for beg of rnd. Beg working in pattern stitch in this color sequence:

4 rounds in MC.

2 rounds in CC.

Work these 6 rnds 13 times total (78 rnds). Reverse the color sequence and cont in pattern st as follows:

2 rounds MC.

4 rounds CC.

Work these 6 rnds 12 times total (72 rnds). Then, work 2 rnds MC and 3 rnds CC. Cut CC, leaving a long tail—about 2

yards. Unzip the scrap yarn chain and carefully place those sts onto the spare circular needle. Making sure there isn't a twist in the cowl, work "Kitchener st" method to join the beg of the cowl to the end of the cowl. Weave in all ends.

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
