

**KNITCOL**  
**Simple Seamless Cowl**



**Approximate Measurements:**  
11 ¾" wide x 31" circumference

**Materials:**

**Knitcol:**

**4—50g balls, color 62**

**Gauge:** 19 sts, 28 rows= 4" in st st on US Size 7 (4.5mm) knitting needles,

**Needles:** US Size 7 (4.5mm) 24" circular needle + spare circular needle in same size and length, 1 St marker (m), scrap yarn, crochet hook size 4.5mm.

**Begin**

With scrap yarn and crochet hook, work a provisional CO of 110 sts. Cut scrap yarn. With main yarn and circular needle, pick up and k110 sts along the provisional CO. Place m for beg of round.

Beg working in st st in the round (k every round) until piece measures 31". Cut yarn, leaving a long tail—about 3 yards.

Unzip the provisional CO sts and carefully place those sts onto the spare circular needle.

Making sure there isn't a twist in the cowl, work "Kitchener st" method to join the beg of the cowl to the end of the cowl. Weave in all ends and block lightly.

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
