Rekor Mini Balls

Necklace, Bracelet and Headband

Rekor Mini Balls Necklace and Bracelet

Materials:

Rekor Mini Balls of 5 colors 3.25 mm or US size D crochet hook 12 stainless steel washers 1/4" (9 for the necklace, 3 for the bracelet) 2 clasp sets

NECKLACE: Make 10 flowers Ch 6 and join with a sl st to the first ch forming a ring.

Round 1: Ch 1 and work 11 scs into the ring. Join with a sl st into the back loop of the ch that began the round.

Round 2: Ch 4 (counts as a sc and 3 chs) and sc into the back loop of the st. Working into the back loop only. sc, ch 3, sc in each stitch 10 times. In the last st, sc, ch 1, sl st into st and fasten off. (12 ch 3 spaces)

Round 3: Attach yarn to any of the front loops in round 1. Fold back the petals worked on round 2 to work this round.



Ch 3 (counts as sc and 2 chs) Working into the font loop only, sc, ch 2, sc in each st 10 times. In the last st, sc, ch 2, sl st into st and fasten off. (12 ch 2 spaces)

Join by working the yarn from the edge of the flower around the washer or clasp 3 or 4 times.

<u>BRACELET</u>: (Make 4 flowers) Work as the necklace.

HINTS:

As with any motif patterns that are joined, it is advantageous to minimize the number of ends to be worked in. Leave a little longer strand than usual when cutting the yarn after Rounds 2 and 3. These ends can be used to attach the flower to a washer or clasp.

When beginning Round 3 choose a loop opposite the beginning of the previous round.

When working the scs in Round 1 work into the ring and the end that began the ch.

If you are using a clasp formed by a rod which is inserted into a circle, this requires at least 1/2" length from the rod to the flower. Make the strands forming this attachment the necessary length, then twist the yarn around the strands several times before you work in the end.

Rekor Mini Balls Sawtooth Crown Headband

Approximate Measurements: One size to fit most children 16" x 2". (shown with 2 headbands worn together)

Materials: Rekor Mini Balls of 2 colors

Needles: US size 5 (3.75 mm), tapestry needle.

Gauge: 22sts = 4" in Sawtooth Pattern on size US 5 (3.75 mm) needle, or size needed to obtain gauge.



Begin Sawtooth Pattern:

Cast on 5 sts.

Row 1: (RS) SI 1knitwise, yo, k2tog, yo, k2.
Row 2: and all WS rows: S11purlwise, k to end.
Row 3: SI 1knitwise, [yo, k2tog] 2 times, yo, k1.
Row 5: SI 1 knitwise, [yo, k2tog] 3 times, yo, k2.
Row 7: SI 1knitwise, [yo, k2tog] 3 times, yo, k1.
Row 9: SI 1 knitwise, [yo, k2tog] 3 times, yo, k2.
Row 11: SI 1 knitwise, [yo, k2tog] 4 times, yo, k1.
Row 13: SI 1 knitwise, [yo, k2tog] 4 times, yo, k2.
Row 15: Bind off 8 sts, yo, k2tog, yo, k1.
Row 16: Repeat Row 2.
Repeat rows 1-16 for a total of 8 times or desired length.

Bind off.

Sew cast on edge to bound off edge. Weave in all ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS: RS = right side, WS = wrong side, SI1= slip 1 stitch, yo= yarn over, k=knit, k2tog=knit 2 together, st(s)=stitch(es)
