

GOLD RUSH Headband



To Fit head size: 21", (22) circumference
Finished Size: 20", (21) circumference

Materials:

Gold Rush: 1, (1)—25G cone, color 9 Copper
Gauge: 27 sts, 35 rows= 4" in garter st (k every row) on US size 6 (4mm) moderately stretched lengthwise.

Needles: US Size 6 (4mm) straight knitting needles, scrap yarn for provisional CO, Size 4.5mm crochet hook

Pattern is written for smallest size, with larger sizes in parenthesis. If only one number is given, it applies to both sizes.

Begin

With crochet hook and scrap yarn, Chain 27 sts. Cut scrap yarn and join main yarn.

Row 1: Sl1 wyib, k to end of row.

Rep this row 174, (184) times more.

Piece should measure 20", (21), moderately stretched.

Unravel the scrap yarn from CO and graft the CO and BO sts tog- making sure there is no twist. You can either do "Kitchener stitch" or "3 needle bind off" method- your choice. Wrap a strand of yarn around the headband and secure tightly to cinch the front. Weave in all ends.

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
