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BABY ALPACA GRANDE HAND DYED Mistake Rib Stitch Hat



Begin

With circular needle, long tail CO 60, (64) sts. Join in the rnd, and pm. Work in mistake rib st for 6", (7). **Dec Rnds**

(Switch to DPNs)

Rnd 1: *K2, k2tog; rep from * around. 45, (48) sts. Rnd 2: *K1, k2tog; rep from * around. 30, (32) sts. Rnd 3: *K2tog; rep from * around. 15, (16) sts. Rnd 4: K1, (0), *k2tog; rep from * around. 8, (8) sts. Cut yarn and draw through rem sts. Weave in all ends.

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To Fit: Kids, (Adult)

Approximate Circumference: 20", (21 ½)

Materials:

Baby Alpaca Grande Hand Dyed: 1, (1)—100G skeins, color 144 Autumn

Gauge: 12 sts, 20 rows= 4" in mistake rib st on US

Size 11 (8mm) knitting needles.

Needles/Notions: US Size 11 (8mm)-16" circular and DPNs,

1 st marker (m).

Pattern is written for smallest size, with larger sizes in parenthesis. If only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

Mistake Rib Stitch (Multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: *k2, p2; rep from *

Rnd 2: k1, *p2, k2; rep from *, end p2, k1.

Rep these 2 rnds for pattern st.
