

GALWAY SPORT
Granny Square Cowl



Approximate Measurement:
8” wide x 32” circumference

Materials:

Galway Sport:

1—50G ball of EACH color—we used
13 Purple, 756 Pumpkin, 722 Taupe,
766 Raisin

Gauge: 4” x 4” = 1 Granny Square on
US E (3.5mm) crochet hook.

Needles/Notions: US Size E (3.5mm) crochet
hook.

Color Sequence 1 (Make 4 Squares total)
Purple, Pumpkin, Taupe, Raisin

Color Sequence 2 (Make 4 Squares total)
Pumpkin, Taupe, Raisin, Purple

Color Sequence 3 (Make 4 Squares total)
Taupe, Raisin, Purple, Pumpkin

Color Sequence 4 (Make 4 Squares total)
Raisin, Purple, Pumpkin, Taupe

Granny Square

With first color, Ch 4. Join with a sl st to
form a ring.

Rnd 1: With first color, Ch 3 (counts as
first DC), 2 DC into ring, *Ch3, 3 DC into
ring; rep from * 2 times more, Ch3, sl st
into top of first Ch3. *Cut first color.*

Rnd 2: With second color, Sl st into any

corner Ch3 space, Ch3 (counts as first DC), 2 DC into same Ch3 space, *Ch2, skip 3 DC, (3 DC Ch3, 3DC) in the next Ch3 space (corner made); rep from * 2 times more, Ch2, 3 DC in the same space as first half corner, Ch3, sl st into the top of the first Ch3. *Cut second color.*

Rnd 3: With third color, Sl st into any corner Ch3 space, Ch3 (counts as first DC), 2 DC into same Ch3 space, *Ch2, 3 DC in next Ch2 space, Ch2 (3 DC, Ch3, 3 DC) in next corner space; rep from * 2 times more, Ch2, 3 DC into the next Ch2 space, Ch2, 3 DC in the same space as first half corner, Ch3, sl st into the top of the first Ch3. *Cut third color.*

Rnd 4: With fourth color, Sl st into any corner Ch3 space, Ch3 (counts as first DC), 2 DC into same Ch3 space, *(Ch2, 3 DC) in each of the next Ch2 space, Ch2 **, (3 DC, Ch3, 3 DC) in corner space; rep from * 2 times more, rep from * to ** once, 3 DC in same space as first half corner, Ch3, sl st into the top of the first Ch3. *Cut fourth color.* One granny square is complete.

Make a total of 16 granny squares.

Arrange them in any color sequence you like so that they are 2 squares wide x 8 squares long. Sew them tog, then sew the top 2 and bottom 2 squares tog to form a circle. Use any color you like to work single crochet along the edges. Weave in all ends. ©2014 Plymouth Yarn Company. 092214vle. Designed by Vanessa Ewing
