# Toy Box Rainbow Baby Beret 



Beret To Fit Size: 3-6, (9-12, 18-24) months

## Materials:

ToyBox Rainbow:
1, (1, 1)—100G balls, \#108 Denim
Gauge: 20 sts, 40 rows $=4$ " in garter st in the rnd ( k 1 rnd , p 1 rnd ) on US Size 7 ( 4.5 mm ) knitting needles.
Needles/Notions: US Size 5 ( 3.75 mm ) \& 7 ( 4.5 mm ) 16 " circular needle, US Size 7 ( 4.5 mm ) DPNs, 1 st marker (m).

Pattern is written for smallest size, with larger sizes in parenthesis. If only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

## Beret

With smaller circular needle, CO 64, $(72,80)$
sts. Join in the rnd and pm.
Rib Rnd: *K1tbl, p1; rep from * around.
Rep this rnd for 1 ".
Switch to larger circular needle and beg working in garter st ( k 1 rnd , p 1 rnd ) for 4 rnds . Inc Rnd 1: *K4, m1; rep from * around- 16 , $(18,20)$ sts inc'd. $80,(90,100)$ sts.
K 3 rnds in garter st, starting with a p rnd.

Inc Rnd 2: *K5, m1; rep from * around-16, $(18,20)$ sts inc'd. $96,(108,120)$ sts. K 15 rnds in garter st, starting with a p rnd.

## Dec For Crown

(Switch to DPNs when necessary)
Dec Rnd 1: *K4, ssk; rep from * around-16, $(18,20)$ sts dec'd. $80,(90,100)$ sts.
K 3 rnds in garter st, starting with a p rnd.
Dec Rnd 2: *K3, ssk; rep from * around-16, $(18,20)$ sts dec'd. $64,(72,80)$ sts. K 3 rnds in garter st, starting with a p rnd.
Dec Rnd 3: *K2, ssk; rep from * around-16, $(18,20)$ sts dec'd. $48,(54,60)$ sts. K 3 rnds in garter st, starting with a p rnd.
Dec Rnd 4: *K1, ssk; rep from * around-16, $(18,20)$ sts dec'd. $32,(36,40)$ sts. K 3 rnds in garter st, starting with a p rnd. Dec Rnd 5: *Ssk; rep from * around- $16,(18,20)$ sts dec'd. $16,(18,20)$ sts. P 1 rnd. Rep dec rnd 5-8, $(9,10)$ sts rem.
Cut yarn, leaving a tail of about 4". Thread the tail through the rem sts and fasten off. Weave in all ends. Make a pom pom, if desired, and attach to the top.

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ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), $\mathrm{BO}=$ bind off, $\mathrm{CO}=$ cast on, cont= continue, dec= decrease, $\mathrm{DPNs}=$ double pointed needles, inc= increase, $m=$ marker, patt= pattern, $p m=$ place marker, psso= pass slipped stitch over, $p=$ purl, rem= remain(ning), rep= repeat, rnd=round, $R S=$ right side, $s l=$ slip, $S S K=$ slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tbl = through back loop, tog = together, WS= Wrong Side
