

WORSTED MERINO SUPERWASH HAND DYED
Moss Stitch Cowl



Approximate Measurements:
7 ½" at widest x 51" circumference

Materials:

WMSW Hand Dyed:

2—100G skeins, color 110 Blueberry

Gauge: 17 sts, 32 rows = 4" on size US 8 (5mm) in seed st.

Needles/Notions: US Size 8 (5mm)-24" or 32" circular needle, 1 st marker (m).

Seed St

Rnd 1: P1, *K1, p1; rep from * around.

Rep this rnd throughout.

Begin

(Due to the nature of the hand dyed yarn, it is best to alternate every 2 rounds with 2 different skeins so that the color is more consistent throughout the whole project.)

Long tail CO 215 sts. Make 1 twist in the CO, then join in the rnd. PM. Work in seed st for 6".

Edging

(It may be easiest to



work with just 1 strand of yarn for the edging. You will be working in rows and not in the rnd from here on out.) Cable CO 3 sts onto the left hand needle, then work across the row as follows:

Row 1 (RS): K1, yo, k1, ssk, turn.

Row 2: S11 wyib, k3, turn.

Row 3: K2, yo, k1, ssk, turn.

Row 4: S11 wyib, k4, turn.

Row 5: K3, yo, k1, ssk, turn.

Row 6: S11 wyib, k5, turn.

Row 7: K4, yo, k1, ssk, turn.

Row 8: S11 wyib, k6, turn.

Row 9: BO4 sts, k1, ssk, turn.

Row 10: S11 wyib, k2, turn.

Rep these 10 rows across all sts of the cowl. BO rem 3 sts. Weave in all ends and block.

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ABBREVIATIONS: BO= bind off, CO= cast on, cont= continue, m= marker, PM= place marker, p = purl, rem= remaining, rep= repeat, rnd=round, RS= right side, sl = slip, SSK = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, wyib= with yarn in back, yo= yarn over
