

## OSKAR Seafoam Cowl



**Approximate Dimensions:**  
47” circumference, 11” wide

**Materials:**

**Oskar: 1—200g skein, shown in color 6 on model**

**Gauge:** 8 sts, 9.5 rows = 4” on a US 15 (10mm) needle over *seafoam stitch pattern* after blocking.

**Needle:** US 15 (10mm) -32” circular.

Please note that there is no wrong or right side of work because the stitch is reversible. The cowl is worked flat and sewn together afterward.

Long tail CO 96 sts.

Begin seafoam stitch pattern:

Row 1: Knit all sts.

Row 2: Knit all sts.

Row 3: K5, \*K1—wrapping yarn around the needle 3 times, K1—wrapping yarn around the needle 4 times, k1—wrapping yarn around the needle 5 times, k1—wrapping yarn around the needle 4 times, k1—wrapping yarn around the needle 3 times, k5; rep from \* to last st, k1.

Row 4: Knit across, dropping all extra wraps—96 sts still on needle.

Rows 5 and 6: Knit all sts.

Row 7: \*K1—wrapping yarn around the needle 3 times, K1—wrapping yarn around the needle 4 times, K1—wrapping yarn around the needle 5 times, K1—wrapping yarn around the needle 4 times, K1—wrapping yarn around the needle 3 times, k5; rep from \* to last 6 sts, K1—wrapping yarn around the needle 3 times, K1—wrapping yarn around the needle 4 times, K1—wrapping yarn around the needle 5 times, K1—wrapping yarn around the needle 4 times, K1—wrapping yarn around the needle 3 times, end k1.

Row 8: Knit across, dropping all extra wraps—96 sts on needle.

Repeat rows 1-8—twice more—24 rows total. Then work rows 1-2 once more. BO all sts loosely in knit on next row.

Sew the side edges of the cowl together.

Block to measurements—pull the cowl moderately width-wise so that the yarn over loops fully extend.

Weave in all ends.



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
