**Cable Hat**



**To Fit Average Adult**

**Materials:**

**Artist: 1—100g ball, color 5915 Blue/Purple Mix**

**Gauge:** 13 sts, 18 rows= 4” in st st on US Size 10 (6mm) or size to obtain gauge, *after blocking*.

**Needles/Notions:** US Size 8 (5mm) and 10 (6mm)- 16” circular, US Size 10 (6mm) DPNs, 1 st marker (m), 1 cable needle.

**Cable Pattern** (Multiple of 11 sts)

**Rnd 1:** \*K1, yo, k2tog, k4, ssk, yo, k2; rep from \*

**Rnd 2 and all even numbered rnds:** K all sts.

**Rnd 3:** \*Yo, k2tog, k6, ssk, yo, k1; rep from \*

**Rnd 5:** Same as rnd 1.

**Rnd 7:** \*Yo, k2tog, C6F, ssk, yo, k1; rep from \*

**Rnd 8:** K all sts.

Repeat these 8 rnds for pattern.

**Begin**

With smaller circular needle, CO 66 sts.

Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist. PM.

Work in 1x1 rib (k1 st. p1 st) for 10 rnds.

Switch to larger needle begin working in Cable Pattern. When hat measures approximately 8 ¼” from CO edge, begin shaping the top:

**Dec Rnd 1:** \*K1, k2tog; rep from \* across. 44 sts.

**Dec Rnd 2:** K across all sts.

**Dec Rnd 3:** \*K2tog; rep from \* across. 22 sts.

**Dec Rnd 4:** K across all sts.

**Dec Rnd 5:** \*K2tog; rep from \* across. 11 sts.

Cut yarn and draw through remaining sts.

Weave in all ends. Block the cable pattern lightly—do not block ribbing.

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
