

**AREQUIPA WORSTED AND FUR
Striped Cowl**



Approximate Dimensions:
20 ¾" circumference, 9" long

Materials:

Arequipa Worsted: 1—100G ball, color 305 DK Grey

Arequipa Fur: 1—50G ball, color 205 DK Grey

Gauge: 12 sts, 20 rows = 4" using size US Size 11 (8mm) knitting needle using **Worsted held double** *after blocking*.

Needles/Notions: US Size 11 (8mm)- 24" circular needle, 1 st marker (m).

Always hold the Arequipa Worsted double in this pattern. When working the stripe sequence, there is no need to cut the non-working yarn. Instead, carry it up the inside (WS) of the cowl, twisting the strands tog at the beg of the rnd.

Begin

With Fur, long tail CO 62 sts. Join in the rnd and pm.

Stripe Sequence

K 5 rnds with Fur. K 8 rnds with Worsted

Work these 13 rnds 3 times total.

K 5 rnds with Fur. BO loosely on next rnd in Fur.

Weave in all ends. Block lightly.



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
