

**BABY ALPACA DK
Striped Cowl**



Approximate Measurements:
9 ½” wide x 34 ¾” circumference
After blocking

Materials:

Baby Alpaca DK:
1—50G ball EACH OF 4 COLORS: We used 7754 Green, 7757 Brown, 7721 Teal, 7556 Taupe

Gauge: 18 sts x 24 rows = 4” on US Size 8 (5mm) needle *after blocking*.

Needles/Notions: US Size 8 (5mm)-24” circular needle plus a spare circular, scrap yarn, 1 st marker (m), 5mm crochet hook.

Color Sequence

MC= 7754 Green, CC1= 7757 Brown
CC2= 7721 Teal, CC3= 7556 Taupe

Begin

With scrap yarn and crochet hook, chain 86 sts. Cut scrap yarn. With MC and circular needle, pick up and k 86 sts along the chain. Place m for beg of rnd.

Work **first** color sequence:

4 rnds in MC. 4 rnds in CC1.

Work these 8 rnds 6 times total (48 rnds).

Then work 4 rnds MC. Then work **second** color sequence:

4 rnds CC1. 4 rnds CC2.

Work these 8 rnds 6 times total (48 rnds).

Work 4 rnds of CC1. Then work **third** color sequence:
4 rnds CC2. 4 rnds CC3.

Work these 8 rnds 6 times total (48 rnds), then work 4 rnds of CC2. Then work **fourth** color sequence: 4 rnds CC3. 4 rnds MC.

Work these 8 rnds 6 times total (48 rnds), then work 3 rnds of CC3.

Cut CC3, leaving a long tail—about 2 yards. Unzip the scrap yarn chain and carefully place those sts onto the spare circular needle.

Knit side facing, making sure there isn't a twist in the cowl, work “Kitchener st” method to join the beg of the cowl to the end of the cowl. Weave in all ends. Block to measurements.

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
