

**CASHMERE PASSION and ANGORA
Trimmed Hood**



**Approximate Finished Measurements
after blocking**
28” circumference w/ Cashmere Passion,
33” circumference w/ Angora,
19 ½” long

Materials:

Cashmere Passion:

4—50g balls, color 20 Grey

Angora:

4—10g balls, color 3027 Teal

Gauge: 20 sts, 40 rows= 4” in garter st on
US Size 8 (5mm) needles with Cashmere
Passion *after blocking*,

17 sts, 34 rows= 4” in garter st on US Size 8
(5mm) needles with Angora *after blocking*.

Needles: US Size 8 (5mm)- 24” circular
knitting needle, 1 st marker (m).

Begin

With Angora, CO 140 sts. Join in the rnd,
being careful not to twist sts. PM.

Work in garter st in the rnd (k 1 rnd, p 1 rnd)
for 7½”- OR until you are almost out of
yarn, end having worked a p rnd.

Then, switch to Cashmere Passion and work in garter st until piece
measures 18 ½” from CO edge. Then, work in st st (k every rnd) for
1”. BO all sts on next rnd.

Weave in all ends and block to measurements.
