

OSKAR
Garter Stitch Hat



To Fit Average Adult—21 ½” circumference

Materials:

Oskar: 1—200g skein color 2

Gauge: 9 sts, 16 rows= 4” in garter st on US Size 13 (9mm) or size to obtain gauge, *after blocking.*

Needles/Notions: US Size 13 (9mm)-16” circular and DPNs, 1 st marker (m).

Begin

With circular needle, CO 48 sts.

Join in the rnd and pm, being careful not to twist sts.

Rib Rnd: *K1tbl, p1; rep from * around.

Rep this rnd for 1 ½”.

Next Rnd: P 1 rnd.

Next Rnd: *K2tog, yo; rep from * across.

Next Rnd: P 1 rnd.

Begin working in garter st- K 1 rnd, p 1 rnd.

Rep these 2 rnds until hat measures 6 ½” from CO edge, end having worked a p rnd.

Shape Crown

(Switch to DPNs when necessary.)

Rnd 1: *K6, k2tog; rep from * across—42 sts.

Rnds 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12: P all sts.

Rnd 3: *K5, k2tog; rep from * across—36 sts.

Rnd 5: *K4, k2tog; rep from * across—30 sts.

Rnd 7: *K3, k2tog; rep from * across—24 sts.

Rnd 9: *K2, k2tog; rep from * across—18 sts.

Rnd 11: *K1, k2tog; rep from * across—12 sts.

Rnd 13: *K2tog; rep from * across—6 sts.

Cut yarn and thread through remaining sts.

Draw tightly. Weave in all ends.

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
