

STAINED GLAZZ
Shawl



Approximate Measurement *after blocking*
55” wingspan x 25” length at center back

Materials:

Stained Glazz:

5—50G balls, color 04 Yellow

Gauge: 11 sts, 20 rows= 4” in st st on US Size 11 (8mm) or size to obtain gauge, *after blocking*.

Needles/Notions: US Size 11 (8mm)- 32” circular needle, 2 stitch markers (m).

Begin

CO 3 sts.

Set up

Row 1: K1, (yo) twice, pm, k1, pm, (yo) twice, k1. 7 sts on needle.

Row 2: K1, (k1, p1tbl) in double yo, sm, p1, sm, (p1, k1tbl) in double yo, k1.

Shawl body

Row 1 (RS): K2, yo, k to m, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2—4 sts inc’d.

Row 2: K to marker, sm, p1, sm, k to end of row, sm as you come to them.

Row 3: Same as row 1.

Row 4: K2, p to last 2 sts, sm as you come to them, k2

Row 5: Same as row 1.

Row 6: Same as row 4.

Rep rows 1 through 6—15 times total—180 sts inc’d. 187 sts on your needle.

Edging

Row 1 (RS): K2, yo, k to m, yo, sm, k1,

sm, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2—4 sts inc’d.

Row 2: K to m, sm, p1, sm, k to end of row, sm as you come to them.

Rep rows 1 through 2—11 times total—44 sts inc’d. 231 sts on your needle. BO all sts loosely on your next row in k.

Finishing

Weave in all ends. Soak your shawl in your favorite wool wash. Roll the shawl in towels to remove most of the water- shawl should be slightly damp but not soaking. Pin out the shawl to measurements and wait for it to dry before removing.

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ABBREVIATIONS: CO= cast on, inc= increase, K= knit, K2tog= knit two together, m= marker, P= purl, PM= place marker, rep= repeat, RS= right side, SM= slip marker, SSK= slip, slip, knit these two stitches together, St(s)= stitch(es), st st= stockinette stitch, tbl= through back loop, tog= together, WS= wrong side, YO= yarn over

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
