

WORSTED MERINO SUPERWASH
Cabled Fingerless Mitts



Approximate Measurements:
7 ½” circumference, 12” long

Materials:

Worsted Merino Superwash:

2—100G skeins, color 26 Sage

Gauge: 20 sts, 28 rows = 4” in st st on US size 7 (4.5mm) needles, 18 sts= 2 ½” in cable pattern on US Size 7 (4.5mm) needles.

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5mm) DPNs, 1 st marker (m), 1 cable needle, scrap yarn.

Cable Pattern (Multiple of 18 sts)

Rnd 1: *P2, K16; rep from * across.

Rnd 2: Same as rnd 1.

Rnd 3: *P2, C8B, C8F; rep from * across.

Rnds 4-10: Same as Rnd 1.

Rnd 11: *P2, C8F, C8B; rep from * across.

Rnds 12-16: Same as Rnd 1.

Rep these 16 rnds for pattern st.

Begin

(Make 2)

CO 54 sts, distributing 18 sts each onto 3 DPNs, place m to mark beg of rnd. Work 4 total rep of cable pattern then work 1-6 once more. (70 rnds).

Thumb Rnd/ Rnd 7 of Cable Pattern:

Pattern 6 sts, K 7 sts with scrap yarn, Place those sts back onto the

left hand needle to be knit again, finish working round 7.

Work rnds 8-16, then work rnds 1-4 once more.

Bind off as follows: *k1, k2tog; rep from * around. Cut yarn, fasten off.

Thumb

Unravel scrap yarn from thumb and distribute 14 sts (7 sts from the top and 7 sts from the bottom) onto 2 DPNs. If necessary, pick up one extra stitch from thumb onto each end of the DPNs so that there won't be a gap. Knit these sts together so that there are still only 14 sts total. Work four rounds in knit. Bind off. Weave in all ends.
