

Big Mo & Encore Worsted Hand Muff



Materials: 2—100g balls of Big Mo- shown in color 6, 1—100g ball Encore Worsted shown in color 520 (used doubled)-- pull Encore from both the inside and the outside of the ball or divide ball into 2—50g balls before use.

Needles: 16 circular size US 11 (8mm); size US 13 (9mm) needle for bind off only; stitch marker.

Gauge: 12 sts, 14 rows = 4" on size 11 needle over stockinette stitch with a double strand of Encore Worsted.

Approx. Finished Size: 16" around x 11" long.

Hand Muff:

With size US 11 needles and a double strand of Encore Worsted, loosely cast on 50 sts. Place marker and join in the round, being careful not to twist the sts. Work in st st (knit every round) until the total length is 10". On the next round, change to 1 strand of Big Mo. Knit 1 round. TURN, and continue knitting- working in st st-

in the opposite direction until total length of this mohair section is 12". Bind off loosely with larger needle. Fold Big Mo section back over the WS of the Encore Worsted section so that the RS (knit side) of the Encore Worsted section is seen as the lining, and the WS (purl side) of the Big Mo section is the outside of the muff. Loosely sew up the cast on edge to the bind off edge. Weave in all ends.

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
