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# **HOMESTEAD TWEED Hot Water Bottle Cover**



Rnd 15: \*P1, k3, p1, k1; rep from \* across Rnd 16: \*K5, p1; rep from \* across Rep these 16 rnds for pattern stitch.

To Fit Average Hot Water Bottle: 10 ½" tall (not including neck) x 15" circumference Measured unfilled

# **Materials:**

#### **Homestead Tweed:**

1—100G skein color 502 Taupe Tweed

**Gauge:** 16 sts, 20 rows= 4" in st st and **pattern stitch** US Size 8 (5mm) knitting needles *after blocking*.

Needles: US 8 (5mm)- 16" circular needle, US Size 8 (5mm)

DPNs, 2 st markers (m).

## Pattern Stitch (Multiple of 6 sts)

Rnds 1 and 2: K all sts.

Rnd 3: \*K5, p1; rep from \* across.

Rnd 4: \*P1, k3, p1, k1; rep from \*.

Rnd 5: \*K1, p1; rep from \* across.

Rnd 6: \*P1, k1; rep from \* across.

Rnd 7: K1, p1, k1, p1, \*k3, p1, k1, p1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

<u>Rnd 8:</u> K2, \*p1, k5; rep from \* to last 4 sts, p1, k3

Rnds 9 and 10: K all sts.

Rnd 11: K2, p1, \*k5, p1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k3.

Rnd 12: K1, \*p1, k1, p1, k3; rep from \* to last 5 sts, p1, k1, p1, k2.

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 $\underline{\text{Rnd 13:}}$  \*P1, k1; rep from \* across.

Rnd 14: \*K1, p1; rep from \* across.

#### **Begin**

With DPNs, CO 36 sts, leaving a long tail for seaming and placing a mafter 18 sts. Join in the rnd and pm to mark beg of rnd.

### **Increase for Body**

Rnd 1: K all sts.

Rnd 2: \*K1, m1, k to 1 st before m, m1, k1, sl m; rep from \* once more—4 sts inc'd. 40 sts on needle.

Work rnd 2—6 times total. 60 sts on needle. Switch to circular needle and work 2 rnds even in k. Work 2 rep in **pattern stitch**—32 rnds total. Then, work in st st until piece measures 9 ½" from CO edge.

#### **Decrease for Neck**

(Switch to DPNs when necessary.)

<u>Dec Rnd:</u> \*K1, ssk, k to 3 sts before n, k2tog, k1, sl m; rep from \* once more—4 sts dec'd. 56 sts on needle. Work Dec Rnd 6 times total. 36 sts on needle.

# Neck

Rib Rnd: \*K2, p2; rep from \*.

Work the rib rnd for 6". BO all sts using your favorite stretchy BO method.

Sew the bottom CO sts tog. Weave in all ends. Block.

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ABBREVIATIONS: beg= begin(ning), BO= bind off, CO= cast on, DPNs= double pointed needles, inc= increase, k = knit, m= marker, m1= make on, pm= place marker, p = purl, rnd= round, rep= repeat, RS= right side, sl = slip, st(s) = stitch(es), SSK= slip, slip, knit these 2 sts together, st st = stockinette st, tog= together
